#### **SPRINT**

Beginners who run either alone, or in teams of 2 may will be included in Open category. More experienced runners will participate to the following categories: Kids (M/W <14); Youth (M/W<18); Elite; Masters (M/W >40), Super Masters (M/W>55); Ultra Masters (M/W>65)

#### **TRAIL O**

The Trail O will be held in the OPEN category (all competitors regardless of gender, age, or disability) and the PARA category (competitors whose disabilities significantly limit their mobility). Answers will be marked with a pin by punching a hole in the correct answer on the map.





## TREASURE HUNTING

One single category, where teams of 2 participants regardless of age and gender are allowed. All teams that collect the clues in 30 minutes will open the treasure chest.

## **MOBILE O**

There will be the following categories: Mixed teams, Open, Advanced. Mixed teams are the teams where mixed participation: disable + non-disable teams are formed, regardless of age and gender, as well as teams where M/W>60 pair with M/W<12.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- Portable toilets will be available at the competition center.
- Each of the first 400 people registered will receive a free participants kit (bag, cup, snack).
- Upon receiving their package, participants sign the appropriate GDPR declaration. Participants consent to the use of their image in photos, videos, and informational and promotional materials for the event.
- The competition will take place in residential areas and parks. Participants are required to follow traffic rules and exercise caution while navigating the route.
- Organizer have bought civil responsibility insurance.
- Organizer does not bear the costs of individual insurance.
- Medical rescuer aid will be available in competition center.
- Organizer reserves the right to final interpretation of bylaws and bulletin.

# **CHECKPOINT CONFIRMATION SYSTEM - explanation of concepts**

#### \*SPORTIdent System

The participant punch checkpoints using a specialized chip card. The checkpoints should be punch in the correct order, as indicated on the map. After crossing the finish line, the competitor punching the FINISH control and then proceeds to the race's SI staff to ocheck their results.

#### \*\*Control point punch

Each checkpoint will feature a red element (called a control point punch) attached to the point with a string. Each perforator has its own dedicated system of needles, which must be used to punch holes in the map at that point. The points should be punched in the correct order as indicated on the map. After completing the course, the competitor will go to the race staff to verify the course and obtain their score.
